Date	Scripture	Questions and points to ponder	Personal thoughts, reflections, ideas, etc. about today's Scripture and questions
Saturday, March 1	John 3:1–18	"For God so loved the world." The essence of the gospel is God's love for the world. People desperately need to know how much God loves them. As you prepare to share the gospel with someone, remember that the good news is that God loved us so much that he gave his own Son for us.	
Sunday, March 2	Matthew 9:35–38	Jesus said: "The harvest is plentiful, but the workers are few." That harvest – those who do not have a relationship with Jesus – includes the majority of the world's population. Would you pray for the Lord of the harvest to send forth more laborers to reach lost people? Would you pray for him to send you?	
Monday, March 3	Jonah 3:1–10	We tend to think of evangelism as a New Testament mandate, but God asked Jonah to go to Nineveh and proclaim a message of redemption and salvation. Where might God be sending you on mission – far or near – to present his truth to others?	
Tuesday, March 4	Colossians 1:27– 29	Jesus Christ is the "hope of glory." Without him, our friends, family members, neighbors and co-workers struggle to find hope. Pray that this truth would stimulate a sense of urgency in you to share this hope with those near to you.	
Wednesday, March 5	Acts 4:33	The resurrection is EVERYTHING when it comes to Christianity. Is this a topic you talk about throughout the year, or just at Easter? How are sharing the resurrection story and the hope of its power with someone?	
Thursday March 6	2 Corinthians 9:8-11	God is good, and he generously provides for what we need. Even in seasons of lack, a healthy practice for spiritual growth is to thank him for his generosity. Where can you acknowledge God's provision in your life and thank him for it?	

Date	Scripture	Questions and points to ponder	Personal thoughts, reflections, ideas, etc. about today's Scripture and questions
Friday, March 7	Matthew 4:18–22	Jesus called the disciples to be "fishers of men." That means that followers of Jesus are, by definition, fishers of men. Do you think of yourself as a "fisher of men?" What needs to change in your life to allow for fishing?	
Saturday, March 8	Colossians 4:2–6	How are you "making the most of every opportunity" when you come into contact with the unchurched? Are you creating opportunities to build relationships with your neighbors, co-workers, the parents of your children's friends, and others? How are you making the most of these opportunities?	
Sunday, March 9	1 Thessalonians 2:1–13	This Scripture is a good example of relational evangelism. "In spite of strong opposition" from the Thessalonians, the apostles continued to love them, work alongside them, and share their lives with them. Do you continue to love and give yourself to those who oppose your beliefs? Does it give you hope that the Thessalonians were eventually won over to Christ?	
Monday, March 10	1 Peter 3:13-15	Are you "prepared to give an answer?" Are you prepared to explain what you believe and why you believe it? Are you prepared to explain why you live differently because you belong to Christ? What do you need to do to be better prepared?	
Tuesday, March 11	Proverbs 19:17	Opportunities for generosity surround us. Today, ask God to open your eyes to participate in his flow of generosity towards others, especially those in material need.	
Wednesday, March 12	Matthew 10:32– 33	What do you think it means to "confess him before men?" Have you ever been ashamed or afraid to talk about Jesus with those who are disconnected from him? Why might that happen to you?	
Thursday, January 13	Acts 4:31	The apostles received the Holy Spirit and started sharing the gospel. The most important ingredient for evangelism is the power of the Holy Spirit. We must rely on his power and not on our persuasiveness or our wisdom. True boldness comes by a filling of the Holy Spirit. Pray for the Holy Spirit to fill you.	

Date	Scripture	Questions and points to ponder	Personal thoughts, reflections, ideas, etc. about today's Scripture and questions
Friday, March 14	Joshua 24:15	God wants to invade every sphere of our lives with his presence. Take time today to dedicate your home to God, and ask for an increase of your awareness of his presence.	
Saturday, March 15	Matthew 5:13-16	Jesus calls us the "salt of the earth" and the "light of the world." Salt penetrates. As salt, we are to penetrate our culture. For that to happen, we must make contact. With whom are you making contact? As light, we are to expose and reveal. With whom are you shedding the light of truth?	
Sunday, March 16	1 Corinthians 9:16–23	The purpose of Paul's missionary journeys was to share the gospel with a lost world. Where is your missionary journey taking you – work, school, your neighborhood, your children's activities, your sports or social activities?	
Monday, March 17	Ephesians 4:29	Generosity has not only to do with the things we own, but also the words we speak. How can you cultivate generosity in your words towards others?	
Tuesday, March 18	Mark 16:14–15	Jesus rebuked the disciples for their hardness of heart and their lack of faith. Is there any hardness of heart in your life that needs to be addressed before you are able to share the gospel with someone? Is there some other obstacle, such as lack of faith?	
Wednesday, March 19	Acts 26:12–18	Jesus told Saul: "I am sending you to them to open their eyes and turn them from darkness to light." How has God stopped you, changed your direction and given you a new commission? Do you believe that Jesus is "sending you" to those He has placed in your sphere of influence – at work, in your neighborhood?	
Thursday, March 20	Acts 4:18–20	If Jesus has come into your life and changed you, why would you hesitate to share your story? Peter and John could not help speaking about what they had seen and heard, even knowing that they would be persecuted for it. How have you experienced rejection, or even persecution, for sharing your faith?	

Date	Scripture	Questions and points to ponder	Personal thoughts, reflections, ideas, etc. about today's Scripture and questions
Friday, March 21	Matthew 28:19– 20	Is the mission of Jesus your mission? True disciples of Jesus adopt the mission of Jesus. And that mission is making disciples. The first step in making disciples is sharing the gospel. To those who respond, the mission also includes helping them to become fully devoted followers of Jesus. Who do you long to see accept Christ and truly follow him?	
Saturday, March 22	John 10:27	Though it can be difficult to discern at times, God makes his voice known to his people. How can you take time this week to cultivate a deeper awareness of God's voice?	
Sunday, March 23	1 John 5:13–15	Do you believe that it is God's will for you to share Jesus with those who are disconnected? Do you believe God will help you share the gospel with others? If so, then have confidence that God will answer your prayers and partner with you as you step out in evangelism.	
Monday, March 24	Acts 8:26–40	The Ethiopian said, "How can I (understand this Scripture) unless someone explains it to me?" It is our responsibility to explain the gospel to those who do not understand. Are you prepared to do that? Are you prepared to share your personal testimony of how you became a Christian and what Jesus means to you?	
Tuesday, March 25	Psalm 16:11	We are welcomed to come close to God in order to enjoy him and to experience joy for ourselves. When was the last time you felt authentic joy towards God? Or his enjoyment of you? Is there anything that could hinder that feeling?	
Wednesday, March 26	1 Corinthians 2:1-5	Jesus sent Paul to preach the gospel, but not with persuasive words of human wisdom. There is power in the gospel itself. When you engage in spiritual conversations, do you rely on your own thoughts or wisdom, or God's power? As you engage with unchurched people, ask God to fill you with his words and power.	
Thursday, March 27	James 2:17	Practicing authentic Christian faith takes God's grace. It's not something we can do on our own, especially in moments where courage is required. Pray that God would give you courage, along with kindness, during those times.	

Date	Scripture	Questions and points to ponder	Personal thoughts, reflections, ideas, etc. about today's Scripture and questions
Friday, March 28	Malachi 3:10	Generosity requires trusting in God's goodness towards us. This is simple to state, but difficult to do. Pray that God would increase your faith and your awareness in God's goodness.	
Saturday, March 29	1 Kings 19:11-12	During those moments of anxiety and stress, it's easy to lose track of God's voice. Take some time to pray for stillness of heart and the ability to hear his voice in difficult moments.	
Sunday, March 30	Ephesians 6:19– 20	Do you believe that when you enter into spiritual conversations with those disconnected that God will actually give you his words for them? Even Paul, the master missionary and evangelist, asked others to pray for him. Who are your evangelism prayer partners?	
Summarize what you have heard from the Lord over the last 39 days, and consider sharing them with your group or other friends and family.
